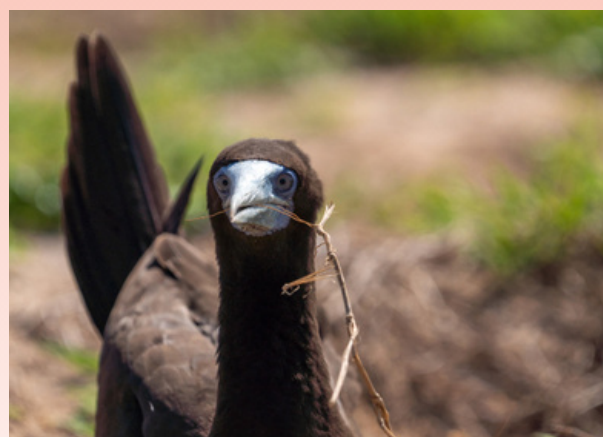

Kanak Vision of the Ocean

Embracing Kanak knowledge and cultural values in the Coral Sea Nature Park Management practices has been the goal of the work for the Kanak Vision of the Ocean (KVO).

Established in 2014, spanning 1.3 million square kilometers, the Coral Sea Nature Park protects a third of the world's near-pristine coral reefs providing a safe home for humpback whales, sharks and sea turtles. It encompasses deep-sea basins, trenches and 149 seamounts.
